Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What volunteer opportunity details are needed to register?

Q: How do I register a project?

A: Registration for projects can be found here:

Q: Is there a limit to the number of projects we can submit?

A: No. Please submit the number of projects you can appropriately support for your organization. You must register each project separately.

Q: Who can submit projects?

A: Any local nonprofit, community organization, school, or university department/program/etc can submit a project.

Q: What happens after the project form has been submitted?

A: Our team will review your submission and follow up to confirm details. You'll receive final confirmation and volunteer roster approximately three weeks before the event.

Q: What types of projects are appropriate?

A: Projects that are safe and suitable for volunteers of varying skill levels and be completed within a 2–4 hour timeframe.

Q: Will volunteers be trained?

A: Volunteers, unless otherwise requested, will not have any specific prior training. We ask that each site have a point of contact available to provide guidance, answer questions and provide any necessary day of training.

Q: Can we request a specific group of volunteers (students with certain skills)?

A: Yes, this request can be indicated in the project submission form

Q: If canceled because of rain will you help us reschedule?

A: We are unable to reschedule any service projects canceled the day of.

Q: Will we be required to provide transportation to our service sights? A: No

Q: What will volunteers be wearing?

A: Volunteers will be asked to wear comfortable clothing and closed toed shoes.

Q: Are we required to provide accommodations?

A: Any request for accommodations will be discussed and arranged on a case by case basis.
